FHWien der WKW in Perugia: Journalism Students Report on the International Journalism Festival 2018

Vienna, April 11, 2018 – For the second time, selected students from Bachelor's and Master's programs in the study program Journalism & Media Management at FHWien der WKW will report on the International Journalism Festival in Perugia. In cooperation with DER STANDARD and under the direction of Harald Fidler, the aspiring journalists will report live from the festival – the contributions are published at derstandard.at. The International Journalism Festival takes place from April 11-15, 2018 and is held for the twelfth time.

Since 2006, the city in the Italian region of Umbria has been the destination of journalists and media professionals from around the world to discuss current trends in journalism. This year's focus is on the state and future of media and journalism. More than 700 speakers and 300 sessions take place within the five days of the festival in the historic town center of Perugia.

"The International Journalism Festival in Perugia is a unique opportunity for all aspiring journalists to get in touch with colleagues from all over the world and to get a feel for current trends in journalism. Harald Fidler is the department head of media at DER STANDARD. He teaches at FHWien der WKW and is also author of the publication "Österreichs Medienlandschaft von A bis Z" ("Austria's Media Landscape from A – Z"), now digitally available at diemedien.at.
