### **FHWien der WKW Awards in Cooperation with Junge Wirtschaft Wien Two Scholarships for MBA Program**

**Applications for a scholarship of 13,000 euros and a partial scholarship of 6,500 euros for the International MBA in Management & Communications will be accepted until April 30.**

*Vienna, April 10, 2019* - With the award of the scholarship, FHWien der WKW and Junge Wirtschaft offer a unique opportunity to deal even more intensively with one's own role as a manager in the sense of lifelong learning. Modern managers are required to have a sound management education as well as a high level of communication skills. Target group of the two scholarships are decision makers with or without economic background, who would like to deepen their leadership skills or qualify for higher managerial functions. A preliminary university degree is advantageous, but not necessary.

#### **Interested parties can apply for a scholarship as follows**

Interested applicants should send their application documents for the scholarship (CV and letter of motivation) by e-mail with the subject "International MBA Scholarship 2019" to [mba@fh-wien.ac.at](mailto:mba@fh-wien.ac.at) by April 30, 2019. In the e-mail, they specify which scholarship (full or partial scholarship or both) they apply for. An independent jury will then review the applications. The best candidates will be invited to a personal assessment. The winners will be announced immediately after the assessment in mid-May 2019. The remaining tuition fees for the MBA scholarship are 6,500 euros for a full scholarship and 13,000 euros for a partial scholarship. Legal recourse is excluded.

#### **International MBA in Management & Communications**

The International MBA in Management & Communications at FHWien der WKW is a comprehensive continuing education program for these two areas of competence. Highlights are the two-week module abroad in Vancouver, the strategy module "Microeconomics of Competitiveness" based on original materials from the prestigious Harvard Business School and the career-friendly block form. The three-semester MBA program corresponds to the European MBA Guidelines and is FIBAA accredited. The program starts on September 20, 2019, with study hours on Fridays from 2:00 to 9:45 p.m. and on Saturdays from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., approximately 10 times per semester.
